

COLLABORATION FOR IMPACT: PEER LEARNING & ACTION COHORT

A virtual program for collaboratives to learn, share, and support one another as they work towards population and community-level change



ABOUT THE COHORT

This practitioner-centered program supports leaders and teams strengthening place- and issue-based collaborations for social change. Each six-month virtual cohort brings together backbone teams, nonprofit and community leaders, and cross-sector partners working toward shared goals. Designed to meet participants where they are—whether exploring new partnerships or refining an existing model—the program provides structured support through virtual convenings, coaching, workshops, and facilitated peer learning spaces that build the skills and support networks needed to drive long-term impact. Post-cohort support will include continued access to the cohort platform, resources, alumni network, and convening. The first cohort is expected to launch in Spring 2025.

WHY THIS MATTERS

Collaboration is essential for addressing complex social challenges, yet many leaders and organizations lack the structured support needed to build and sustain effective partnerships. Too often, cross-sector efforts struggle with misalignment, limited resources, and the challenge of turning shared goals into meaningful action.

For over a decade, Root Cause has supported collective action initiatives and heard a common theme: leaders need more structured opportunities for peer connection, shared learning, and ongoing support. This cohort is designed to meet that need helping leaders strengthen collaboration, navigate challenges, and drive lasting impact in their communities.
